Dear Ms. Brandon-

I have left a voice mail asking if you are the contact for our organization to request an increase in the micro purchase threshold.

HHS is our cognizant agency, and a colleague of mine previously contacted you for the same request.

In the event that you are my contact, our organization would like to request an increase in our micro purchase threshold from \$10,000 to \$25,000.

Attached are our audited financial statements, single audit and current indirect cost rate agreement for the year ended September 30, 2017.

The reasons for this request are as follows:

- 1. As stated on Page 9 of our Single Audit report, we qualify as a low-risk auditee.
- 2. We have had no external audit findings related to internal controls in our financial statements, or over compliance of our federal awards.
- 3. A threshold amount of \$25,000 for micro purchases will enable us to increase the efficiency of our operations.
